FOR THE SPONSORSHIP OFFER ON THE OCCASION OF THE ITALIAN NATIONAL DAY AND CULTURAL EVENTS THAT THE CONSULATE GENERAL IN LAGOS WILL ORGANIZE IN THE COURSE OF THE YEAR 2026

The Consulate General of Italy in Lagos,

according to the Art. 43 of the Law of 27 December 1997, n. 449 (Sponsorship contracts and collaboration agreements, agreements with public or private entities, user contributions for non-essential public services and measures to encourage productivity);

according to the Art. 29 of Presidential Decree no. 54/2010;

according to the Art. 19 and Art. 80 of Legislative Decree n. 50/2016 (Code of public contracts);

according to the Art. 6 of the Decree of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of 2 November 2017, n. 192

ANNOUNCES THAT

it intends to proceed with this public notice in search of interested parties to sponsor the organization of the Italian Republic Day 2026 and various cultural events such as piano concert, symphony concert, artistic creation/exhibition, Italian film projection (each of these events will be followed by a cocktail) to be held in Lagos during the year 2026, in the form of financial donations and / or direct provision of goods and services. The operators that have expressed interest will be contacted to negotiate, in compliance with the principles of impartiality and equal treatment referred to in Art. 19 of the aforementioned Legislative Decree No. 50/2016, the terms of the sponsorship contract.

This Consulate General reserves the right to refuse offers which could give rise to a conflict of interest, prejudice or damage to the image and activities of this Office, which are contrary to the general principles of public order or prohibited by law or otherwise received from parties that do not have capacity to contract with the Public Administration.
